



### Belize 2007 Needs List:

Player Scholarships	\$1500	Will pay for one (1) player to go on mission
Transportation costs	\$3000	\$1000 per van (includes gas and insurance)
Bibles	\$1000	One (1) New Testament for every child we see
Educational Scholarships	\$1500 (10)	\$150 per student for school supplies for one (1) year
School Pencil Bags	\$1200	Six hundred (600) bags complete with school supplies
Student Travel	\$750	Five (5) Buses to the Wednesday night youth crusade
Softballs	\$1000	One (1) dozen balls per school visited
Bats	\$400 (2)	Two (2) bats per school visited
Gloves	\$800 (80)	Nine (9) gloves per school visited

#### Explanation

\$1500 pays for a player to go on the mission trip. This includes everything except for his lunches and spending money. With the price of airfare, hotels, and transportation, we run these trips on a very thin margin, we (ISO) make no money off of the trips and the money goes directly to expenses.

Vehicle rental is the biggest costs associated with the trip. With fuel in Belize over \$6 per gallon, the cost of in country travel can add up quickly. We always like to give every child a gift at every clinic. We have learned that while education in Belize is free, school supplies are not. We will be giving all the students a pencil bag with the ISO logo and a Bible verse on it, along with a New Testament at every clinic.

New in 2007, ISO has established a scholarship fund to help ten (10) students with all their schooling costs for the entire year. \$150 will cover one student's school supplies for one school year (uniforms, paper supplies, pencils, markers, etc.)

Wednesday night is the big night during the trip. We will be at the Joan Garbutt Stadium in Esperanza, Belize, Youth from all over Belize will be bused in for a "Youth Crusade Night". ISO has promised to supply five (5) buses from all corners of Belize to transport the youth to the stadium.

The baseball and softball equipment is only one of the tools that we use to get in contact with the youth. Through the simple tools of a game we are able to openly share our faith in ten 10 public schools throughout the week.
