



**Dominican Republic Missions Trip 2009**

**Dates: October 10 – October 17th, 2009**

**Purpose:**

To, through the sport of Baseball, be able to bring the Gospel to people who otherwise would not have the opportunity to hear about Christ. This is a unique opportunity to play a game we enjoy, as well as sharing Jesus with others through developing relationships with another culture.

Saturday	Travel Day – Arrive in D.R.(SDQ), travel to Hotel – relaxing evening at hotel
Sunday	Church (am) – afternoon walkthrough and practice – relaxing evening at hotel/ beach
Monday	Morning Clinic, Sugar Cane Village Outreach – Night Game
Tuesday	Morning Clinic, Afternoon Clinic – Night Game
Wednesday	Morning Clinic, Afternoon Clinic – Night Game
Thursday	Morning Clinic, Orphanage Visit – Night Game
Friday	Snorkeling trip to Catalina Island – Move to the Radisson Hotel (Juan Dolio)
Saturday	Travel Day back to Memphis

**Cost of the Trip: \$1600.00 p/p\***

This includes:

- Airfare from Memphis to Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic (SDQ)
- Ground Transfers from Santo Domingo to Juan Dolio (30 minutes from the airport)
- Ground Transportation during the week
- Hotel accommodations including breakfast, lunch, and dinner
- Uniform washing daily (laundry available for uniforms ONLY)
- Includes \$15 p/p fee for feeding needy in the Sugar Cane Village
  - \$15 usd will feed a village family for a month
- Includes \$20 p/p donation to SCORE missionary for an “Argentinean Cookout”
  - Missionary is the church planter of 4 new churches in D.R.
  - \$10 goes to the food, \$10 goes to the church plants
- Includes \$60 p/p fee Snorkeling trip to Catalina Island (Friday)
  - Approx. 7 hour tour, from Juan Dolio to Catalina Island
  - Beach Buffet
  - Snorkeling

### **Fund Raising**

We will go over individual fundraising during first meeting; ISO will equip you with the tools necessary to fundraise individually for you and your family. Following the criteria that has been tried and true should allow you to raise a portion of your trip costs.

### **Support from your local church:**

Along with helping you personally, your local church can help us with raising money for specific projects. One of the goals for this year is being able to supply each individual student with a pencil bag with school supplies along with gloves, balls and bats. Your trip costs do not include these additional cost and funds will have to be raised separate for these.

### **Accommodations:**

During the week, we will be staying at the SCORE Intl. hotel in the Dominican Republic. This Hotel will become our “base of operations” for the week. The rooming arrangements will be bunk style dormitory quarters. The Hotel has a pool for relaxing and is one block from the beach on the coast. Hotel has round the clock security and the beach is a safe place for you and your family to visit and relax.

### **Uniforms:**

During the clinics Players and Coaches will be asked to wear their team uniform (Mustang, Royals, Tigers, etc. Uniforms and Hats) As a mission team member, you will receive 2 t shirts, one polo shirt, and one team hat or visor. Uniforms only will get washed by the hotel. As a parent of a player, you will need to take enough clothing for the week; there are no laundry services available for normal everyday clothing. Make sure to bring a laundry bag for your dirty clothing.

### **Passports:**

The Dominican Republic requires a valid U.S. passport to enter the country. If you are not in possession of a passport you need to start the process NOW.

### **Team Meeting: (all mission team members, including players, coaches, and parentss)**

We will have 4 team meetings; 9/21, 9/28, 10/5, 10/12. These are **MANDATORY** meetings. During these meetings we will get information to you that you need to know. We will go over clinic training with everybody, all trip members will be required to have a part in the clinic teaching. It will also be a time for us to share what God us doing through this in our live and the lives of those around us. These 4 meeting will set the tone for what kind of trip this will be.
